MANDATORY AND VOLUNTARY RIDERS: The amount of a bill for service will be modified by any Mandatory Rate Riders that must apply and by any Voluntary Rate Riders selected by the Customer, unless otherwise noted in this schedule. See Sections 12.00, 13.00 and 14.00 of the Minnesota electric rates for the matrices of riders.

DEFINITIONS OF SEASONS:

Summer: June 1 through September 30.

Winter: October 1 through May 31.

DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND: The Demand will be determined based on the peak one-hour Demand reading recorded during the Winter period for the most recent 12 months.

DEMAND SIGNAL: Service may receive a Demand signal for up to a total of 14 hours during a 24-hour period, as measured from midnight to midnight. Water heaters served on this schedule also will be included in the Company's Summer water heater load control program.
