Smart thermostats

If you heat or cool with electricity, you may qualify for a **rebate of up to \$150** for eligible smart thermostats.

Eligible thermostat models include certain Tier II (communicating) and Tier III (analytics capable) units.

- Save up to 10 percent on your heating and cooling costs with a Tier II thermostat,

OR

- Save up to 15 percent with a Tier III thermostat.


ePay

Insulation



Hi, there. Here's an interesting fact. A gap along a door jamb is about the same as having a hole to the outside in your wall. Insulating and sealing your home will help lower costs—all year long.

If you heat with electricity, you may qualify for a rebate to update insulation in your home. Qualify for **20 percent of the installation cost, up to \$1,400**, when you work with a contractor and meet R-level requirements.

Does not apply to new construction.

\$500 rebate

for upgrading wall insulation.

\$400 rebate

for air sealing and weather stripping.

Appliance recycling

Get \$50 plus four LED bulbs.

Plenum heaters and electric boiler systems

A plenum heater sits within your duct work just above your furnace to create a dual fuel system. An electric boiler heats liquid for radiator, baseboard, and hydronic floor heating systems. Both offer 100 percent efficient electric heating!


Receive a **rebate of \$500 per unit** when you install a 9 kilowatt or larger plenum heater or electric boiler on the Dual Fuel or Residential Demand Control Rates.

Heat storage systems

A heat storage system may:

- Qualify for a lower rate.
- Reduce heating costs.
- Qualify for rebates.

Install a minimum of 9 kilowatts of heat storage to qualify for a **rebate of \$40 per kilowatt** when installed on our Deferred Load, Residential Demand Control, or Fixed Time of Delivery Rates.



I s'pose I should tell you about heat storage. I store heat. Pretty straightforward. I'm an underfloor unit. You can find other kinds too. We all store heat until you need it.

Water heaters

Ready to update your water heater?

Install an electric water heater that's at least 90 percent efficient on an off-peak rate or monthly bill credit program to qualify for a **rebate of \$150 to \$400**.

Electronically commutated motors


An electronically commutated motor—ECM for short—adjusts air flow and cuts the energy your furnace fan consumes by 75 percent. An ECM:

- Makes a furnace air handling system quieter.
- Reduces temperature fluctuation.
- Reduces the drying effect of winter heating.

Install an ECM with your new heating system—regardless of the fuel type it uses—and get a **\$100 rebate**.

Geothermal and air-source heat pumps generally are equipped with an ECM integrated into the system and won't qualify for this rebate. Learn about heat pump rebates on the next page.

Cold-climate heat pumps



I'm a cold-climate heat pump. I keep the house comfy in all seasons while shredding energy bills. Efficiency pays!

Designed for our weather, cold-climate heat pumps (CCHPs) operate with 200 percent efficiency at 0°F and up to 400 percent efficiency in warmer temps.

A CCHP may qualify for a **rebate of \$600* per ton** when it's:

- Rated with a heating season performance factor (HSPF) of 10 or greater and served on a qualified off-peak rate,

OR

- Meets or exceeds ENERGY STAR® ratings: 15 or greater seasonal energy efficiency rating (SEER), 12.5 or greater energy efficiency ratio (EER), and 10 or greater HSPF, regardless of rate.

AIR-SOURCE HEAT PUMP

Receive a **\$400* per ton rebate** on an ENERGY STAR® qualified **air-source heat pump** or one with a 15 or greater SEER, 12.5 EER, and 8.5 HSPF.

GEOHERMAL HEAT PUMP

Receive an **\$800* per ton rebate** on an ENERGY STAR® qualified **geothermal heat pump** or one with qualified COP and EER ratings.

*Special rules apply for homes heated with natural gas.

DriveOn

Charge your electric vehicle at night—when energy prices are at their lowest. You'll save on driving costs. And install a Level 2 charging station on a qualified rate and receive a **\$400 rebate**.

CoolSavings

I'm enrolled in **CoolSavings**. My AC cycles on and off for 15 minutes when energy use is at its peak. Enroll today and save.



Enroll in **CoolSavings** air-conditioning cycling and save **\$33 on summer cooling costs**. We'll apply an \$8.25 credit to your bills June through September.

- Central AC or heat pumps may qualify.
- Units must be served on a residential service or residential demand control meter to be eligible.
- System must include an outside disconnect switch.
