

Electrical accidents can crop up unexpectedly. Look up. Look down. Look all around.

When moving farm machinery, always walk around the entire vehicle and attachments, looking for hazards before making the next move. And don't forget to:

- **Check your clearance:** Maintain a minimum of ten feet from any part of a utility structure and/or wires. Higher voltage lines require more distance.
- **Use caution if contact occurs:** Stay on your equipment to remain safe and either call 911 or us immediately at 800-257-4044.
- **Think about irrigation equipment placement:** Never stack any farm-related items near or under electrical facilities.
- **Protect surrounding facilities before ditch burning:** Wood poles and plastic risers on poles easily can catch fire and create unsafe conditions.
