

Customer notice

The South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (SDPUC) approved our request to update our Transmission Cost Recovery Rider. This rider recovers costs associated with our transmission projects that help to ensure we continue to provide you with safe, affordable, and reliable service.

The table below applies to bills rendered on and after March 1, 2021. A residential customer using 1,000 kWh in a month will see a bill decrease of \$0.86.
