





## CUSTOMERS' COOKERY

### Moon cake

#### CAKE

- 1 cup water
- ½ cup margarine
- 1 cup flour
- 4 eggs

#### TOPPING

- 2 pkgs (3.4 oz. each) vanilla instant pudding
- 3 ½ cups cold milk
- 1 pkg (8 oz.) cream cheese, softened
- 1 container (8 oz.) frozen whipped topping, thawed

Mix water and margarine over heat. Bring to a boil and remove from heat; add flour and blend. Add eggs one at a time, blending after each. Spread on a greased jelly roll pan and bake at 400 degrees for 25-30 minutes. Cool. Mix pudding with milk and cream cheese, then spread over crust. Top with whipped cream and keep refrigerated.
