- 1. The Residential Time of Day Pilot evaluation period will end one year from the start date, or as determined by the Company and approved by the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission. N

- 2. Participation will be voluntary. The Company will invite participants from Rate M101 and Rate M241 to apply and from those applicants 300 participants will be randomly selected. N

- 3. Customers are required to have an online customer portal account. This is essential for customers to monitor their electricity usage. N
