

Customer notice

The Minnesota Public Utilities Commission approved our request to implement a new Uplift Program rider. The approved monthly charge will become effective September 1, 2022, for the listed classes of customers in the table below who are not receiving Low Income Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) aid.

The Uplift rider recovers costs associated with a low-income affordability program for residential customers that qualify for LIHEAP assistance and apply for the Uplift program. Qualified customers will receive monthly discounts on their bills based upon prior year kWh usage.

The Uplift program:

- Lowers the percentage of income that participating low-income households devote to energy bills.
- Increases participating customer payments over time by increasing frequency of payments.
- Decreases or eliminates past due balances for participating customers.
- Lowers utility costs associated with customer account collection activities.
- Coordinates with other available low-income bill payment assistance and conservation resources.
